On Saturday, September 28th, Kozu hosted day two of the Youth in Asia Science Forum. Students began the day with a lecture on the Asian atmospheric environment by Professor Takenaka from Osaka Metropolitan University. Where students were able to compare the ozone levels in the atmosphere of different Asian country see the effects of airborne pollutants.
